

# Volunteer

Our program depends on a lot of volunteers to organize our activities and operate our events. We ask that every band supporter volunteer to serve in one or more of these areas.

- Pit Crew** - Assisting band with loading/unloading and setup/breakdown of equipment before and after performances.  
*If you can drive a truck , pull a trailer, push a cart or drive a golf cart, help load a truck or enjoy being a part of a team, please consider joining our Pit Crew*
  - Hospitality** - Organizes, and assists with food preparation for Banquets, Evening of Jazz, and for the Directors Suite at events we host.  
*If you can cook, or plan a meal, or organize an event, or serve our guests, please consider joining our Hospitality Group.*
  - Ways & Means** - Organizes and supervises fund raising (and fun raising) events, manage band gear, organize and arrange local restaurants for spirit nights.  
*If you can organize, or persuade, or make phone calls, or keep organized records, or speak in public, please consider joining our Ways and Means Group.*
  - Spirit** - Organizing caravans, decorate vehicles before competitions, and reserves band supporter seating at events.  
*If you have a motivating and enthusiastic personality, or if you are visually creative, or if you can organize a small event, please consider joining our Spirit Group.*
  - Concessions** - Organizing concession duties, operating and maintaining equipment and operating systems. This also includes assisting in feeding students when traveling.  
*If you can cook or clean, or organize or run a cash register or are good working with the public, please consider joining our Concessions Group.*
  - Props and Projects** - Build props for band shows, assists with transporting props.  
*If you are a "handy person" who can build, fabricate, design, or just generally "figure stuff out", please consider joining our Props and Projects Group.*
  - Festival/2A-4A Band Competitions** - Organizes and facilitates events which we host - Primarily the Festival of Bands (Sept 24th) and the 2A/4A Upper State Championship (Oct. 22nd). Duties include but are not limited to:
    - Trophies - Orders trophies and awards, supervises awards at awards ceremony, obtains sponsors for trophies.
    - Spirit Booth - Setup, supervise and sell "happy grams" and "Favorite Director Award" at Festival of Bands.
    - Parking - Supervises spectator and competitor parking.
    - Souvenir Booklet - Design and sell advertising in Programs sold at events.
    - Event Setup/Breakdown - Organize system of setting up and removing tents and equipment before and after events which we host.*If you are good at organizing and working with people, please consider joining our Events Group.*
  - Publicity** - Contact media before and after events, take photographs and video, website development, signs for events, photo video for banquet, recruiting material.
  - Uniform** - Organizes/repairs/orders/issues uniforms.  
*If you can organize, or repair or sew, or like working directly with the students, please consider joining our Uniform Group.*
  - Volunteer** - In charge of calling parents to volunteer for Festival of Bands and 2A/4A Competition
- Section Parent** - Section parents supervise their section at section assigned events (like car wash and concessions), and supervise section related activities (such as students wanting section shirts).
